Therefore, a screening process is in place to help us meet this goal. If you are or have been an ARTrails member you are automatically approved. Any other artists must jury to be included into the event.

At the show a contact list will be distributed that will include a listing of artists and artist contact information for after the event. Postcards will be printed for artists to use to invite their own customers to the show.

Applications are due by **March 16**. Notifications of acceptance, if you need to jury, notifications will be sent by **March 20**. If you have any questions send email to:

# Spring ARTrails Show 2020 Guidelines

- Jury applicants, applications due by March 16
- Booth fee is \$50 per artist, for approximately 50 sq. ft.
- Jury applicants, payable after acceptance, by April 3
- ARTrails members, fee due at application, by March 16
- Artists are not required to be present all three days, but arrangements are to be made with coordinator
- Setup will begin at noon on Thursday and must be completed by 4 pm
- Rectangular tables are available to reserve, but **you will need to bring your own table coverings**
- Please include inventory sheet of all items
- Please mark all items with artist's name, price and description or number
- Artists are to keep booths open for the entire show packing up before 6 pm on Saturday, artist forfeits the chance of returning to the show the next year. If you need to leave early talk to show committee to make arrangements.
- Items must be removed by 9 pm on Saturday
- Show Cash Register will collect all funds for art and sales tax
- VISA and MasterCard will be accepted
- Commission of 20% will be retained by ARTrails, 15% for those that demonstrate their art and help with the show. A list will be sent out upon acceptance.
- Commissions will be sent to the artist within two weeks of show
- Sales Tax will be collected and paid for the artist
- No imported items. Applicants must be original designer and have direct control over production of art
- Artists are responsible for their own setup and breakdown in the space designated to them

## Jury Process

- Screening will be based on Creativity, Originality, Quality and Marketability.
- **We require 5 photos of your artwork, plus one photo of your booth.** These photos can be in the form of Printed Color Photos or Digital files in jpg format.
- **All photos/files need to include the following description:**
  - Artist name and contact information
  - Item dimensions and selling price
  - Brief description of production and materials used
- **Digital files may be saved on CD or emailed to [SpringShow@artrailsofsw.org](mailto:SpringShow@artrailsofsw.org) Subject: [Spring Art Show & last name](#).**
- All files should be a minimum of 300 dpi. Approximately 3 5/8" x 2 3/4", or 1200 x 800 pixels. No more than 400Kb each
- Images will only be returned to you by mail if you include a SASE with adequate postage.

**If you need to jury, we will notify you of acceptance by March 20, 2020.**
