Spring Art Expo 2023 Guidelines

- Jury applicants, for none ARTrails artists applications due by February 17th
- Booth fee is \$70 per artist, for approximately 50 sq. ft
- Half booth fee is \$40 per artist, for approximately 25 sq. ft you must bring your own table
- Jury applicants, payable after acceptance, by March 10th
- ARTrails members, fee due at application, by February 17th

- Setup, you will have the choice of Thursday 1-6 pm prior to the event or Friday morning 7-10am let us know if you will need to be there earlier for setup
- Rectangular tables are available to reserve, but **you will need to bring your own table coverings**
- Artists are to keep booths open for the entire show packing up before 4 pm on Sunday, artist forfeits the chance of returning to the show the next year. If you need to leave early talk to show committee to make arrangements.
- Items must be removed by 9 pm on Sunday
- No imported items. Applicants must be original designer and have direct control over production of art
- Artists are responsible for their own setup and breakdown in the space designated to them

Jury Process

- Screening will be based on Creativity, Originality, Quality and Marketability.
- **We require 5 photos of your artwork, plus one photo of your booth.** These photos can be in the form of Printed Color Photos or Digital files in jpg format. Submit your best photos as they maybe used in digital advertising.
- **All photos/files need to include the following description:**
 - Artist name and contact information
 - Item dimensions and selling price
 - Brief description of production and materials used
- **Digital files may be saved on CD or emailed to SpringArtExpo@gmail.com Subject: **Spring Art Expo & last name.****
- All files should be a minimum of 300 dpi. Approximately 3 5/8" x 2 3/4", or 1200 x 800 pixels. No more than 400Kb each
- Images will only be returned to you by mail if you include a SASE with adequate postage.

If you need to jury, we will notify you of acceptance by February 28, 2023.
