

The History of ARTIGILA of southwest washington

In the spring of 2003, while having dinner after a successful Vernal Equinox Art Fair at Morgan Arts Centre in Toledo, Richard and Susan Roth and Di and Mike Morgan started talking, scheming and dreaming. The four artists decided this area needed something new, something that would involve more artists and that would be a vehicle to build a community of artists.

In early April, they invited 21 Lewis County artists to participate in an artist co-operative event modeled after a similar event held in Sonoma County, California. Working with David Eatwell and the City of Centralia, ARTrails of Southwest Washington was born. The City of Centralia has supported ARTrails from the very beginning. By September, the first ARTrails studio tour became a reality, sending visitors to studios throughout Lewis County. The first Exhibition Gallery was held in the city-owned Wilson Hotel in downtown Centralia and showcased the work of artists from Olympia to Longview and from Morton to Raymond. The next year, and every year since, Centralia has opened the Historic Train Depot to the members of ARTrails for use as the Exhibition Gallery.




